

APPLICATION STATUS

SiS Bolig has sent out the maximum number of housing contracts.

If your application is still "under consideration", you should look for a housing in private market.



WAITING LIST

There is no waiting list.

SiS Bolig will not answer inquiries regarding vacancies.



SIS BOLIG

The Admissions Office is not responsible for student accommodation.

You need to contact SiS Bolig directly for cancellation of housing contract or information relating to student accommodation



FAMILY ACCOMMODATION

There are no family apartments available for students with children.

You must arrange accommodation for your family members

IT USER ACCOUNT AND SERVICES



On Canvas, students can access:

- Required reading List
- Study programme announcements
- Calendar assignment deadlines
- Curriculum and class materials

Students can also communicate with their class and professor(s) on Canvas



Students can find their course schedules and personal semester schedules.

<u>Time edit</u> also lets students book and reserve group study rooms.



Students can search for their reading lists via the <u>reading list</u> system Leganto.



On Student Web/FS, students can:

- Pay the semester fee (NOK 900)
- Register their education plan for the semester
- Submit exams and assignments
- Check grades






Shows if you have a

SEMESTER RECEIPT

Download the Studentbevis app to obtain a digital copy of your semester fee receipt.

You can also order a paper copy of your semester fee receipt through StudentWeb from 'Orders.'

STUDENT CARD

You can order your student card online via StudentWeb. It will be ready after 3-4 days. Bring your ID and semesterfee receipt to the library to pick up your student card.

STUDENT CARD ACCESS

You can use your student card to gain access to campus buildings and the library after the opening hours.

YOUR MOVE TO NORWAY EXPLAINED

POLICE REGISTRATION

For non-EU/EEA students

You are required to register in person at the local immigration office (Stavanger police station) within 7 days of your arrival in Norway.

To book an appointment, go to the Norwegian

Directorate of Immigration (UDI) website and log into
the Application portal.

After the police registration, you will receive a residence card and Norwegian ID number (also called national identity number) in the post. It can take up to **6-8 weeks** after registration to receive them.

Remember to register your correct postal address and name to your mailbox so the letter is delivered to you correctly.



SUA REGISTRATION

For EU/EEA students


Citizens from EU/EEA countries are required to register their stay at the Service Centre for Foreign Workers (SUA) or online within 3 months of their arrival.


First please check if you can upload required documents online at https://www.skatteetaten.no/en/person/national-registry/moving/to-Norway/

If you do not have an electronic ID, you need to report a move on paper. SUA is located at Skatteetaten (the Norwegian Tax Agency), Lagårdsveien 46, 4010 Stavanger.

After this registration, you will receive a *Norwegian ID number* (also called *national identity number*) in the post. It can take up to **4-6 weeks** after registration to receive your Norwegian ID number in the post.

Remember to register your correct postal address and name to your mailbox so the letter is delivered to you correctly.

OPENING A BANK ACCOUNT IN NORWAY RETURNING YOUR DEPOSIT VIA BANK TRANSFER YOUR BANKAXEPT CARD EXPLAINED

DEPOSIT AND BANKAXEPT CARD

For non-EU/EEA students

The international students from non-EU/EEA countries who have transferred a deposit to the University of Stavanger in the process of getting a study permit can access NOK 50 000 shortly after arriving in Stavanger through a bank card called a BankAxept card.

Pick up your BankAxept card at the library reception.

- Please bring sufficient cash until you receive the money on your BankAxept card (1 - 2 weeks)
- This is a temporary solution until you have opened your own bank account in Norway. As soon as you have opened your bank account, we can transfer the rest of the money from the deposit account to your own account.
- Therefore, students who transferred a deposit must open their own bank accounts in Norway.
- The card has a cost of 600 NOK and is voluntary.



Please note that nobody can pick up your BankAxept card except you. It will also take time for you to access the money on your BankAxept card. We advise you to bring enough money for the first two weeks of arrival in Stavanger.

HOW TO OPEN YOUR BANK ACCOUNT IN NOWAY

Once you have registered at the police station or SUA, you will be assigned a national identity number. Your national identity number is required when opening up a bank account in Norway. Opening your bank account can take up to **6-10 weeks**.

After you have received your Norwegian ID number, go to any bank and bring the following documents to open your own account:

1

PASSPORT

Bring you passport as identification for opening your account

2

SKATTEETATEN (TAX OFFICE) LETTER

This letter documents your national identity number given after you registered at the police station or SUA 3

RESIDENCE CARD

Your residence permit if you are from a non-EU/EEA country





RETURNING YOUR DEPOSIT TO YOUR NORWEGIAN **BANK ACCOUNT**

For non-EU/EEA students

Once you have a Norwegian bank account, the remaining balance of your deposit can be transferred to your account.

Go to the library reception with your passport and fill out a form called:

"Deposit Transfer to Norwegian Bank Account"

This must be done in person by the student for identification purposes. You will need the following information to fill out the form:

BACHELOR'S DIPLOMA & TRANSCRIPTS VERIFICATION

DOCUMENT VERIFICATION

All international students need to bring their original documents to be verified upon arrival in Stavanger

You will receive an e-mail in September with instructions to present your documents for verification



Remember to bring the following original documents with you to Stavanger:

If your documents are not in English, Norwegian, Danish or Swedish – you need to bring the official translations accompanying your documents.

Do not show up without an appointment



If you fail to present your original documentation, your study rights at UiS may be revoked





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YOUR HEALTH

TUBERCULOSIS TESTING

"

People from countries with a high occurrence of tuberculosis are obliged to undergo tuberculosis testing if they intend to stay more than three months in Norway.

For students from a high endemic country

who

People from high endemic countries and/or have stayed in one of those countries for more than 3 months

when

Within 4 weeks after arrival in Norway

how

You will be invited to a meeting with the Office of Infection Control (Smittevernkontoret) on campus in the first week of September where you will receive more information about when you can be tested.

HEALTH INSURANCE

Look into insurance options and bring the relevant documents with you to Stavanger

Students staying in Norway for more than one year automatically become insured under the Norwegian National Insurance Scheme once they receive a Norwegian ID number (fødselsnummer). Please note that it can take up to 2-3 months before you receive a Norwegian ID number.

The Norwegian National Insurance Scheme is not a travel insurance.

It does not cover any loss or damage to persons or property that might occur during your stay. Therefore, we urge all students to insure their household contents during their stay in Norway. Theft and burglary in student dormitories may occur.
