



- Learning Agreement
- Confirmation of Arrival
  - Start-date should be the date of your first activity
  - Cannot be earlier than the start of the semester (06.01.25)
- Confirmation of Stay / Departure
  - Usually: End-date is the date of your final exam
  - Cannot be later than the end of the semester (20.06.25)



# Arrival registration


Nordic citizens:

You must book an appointment to <u>report a</u> move to <u>Norway</u>.

EU/EEA and non-EU/EEA citizens:

You must make an appointment to register your arrival through the <u>UDI Application</u>

## Tuberculosis test

- O Mandatory for all students coming from/having spent 3 months in <u>high-risk</u> <u>areas/countries</u>
- O International Office will soon send an invitation to a mandatory information meeting to all students who need to get tested
- O Important to show up for scheduled test appointments.

  The results will not affect your stay in Norway. Any treatment is free of charge


